What is the Point?

3. What is the purpose of baptism? If you were baptized, how significant was this in your spiritual journey?
4. What causes a church to drift from its mission?
5. Pastor Ken had indicated that God often uses suffering to promote His people to action for His mission- like He did with the early church. Can you share of a time when a hardship caused you to be more serious about being obedient to God's mission?
6. Churches that are at the top of a lifecycle tend to have more spectators than volunteers to carry out the work of the mission. How can we as a church stir more participation in our church body?
