1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. What characteristics are present in a church that has become more of a club than a missional church?
3. What things should we do as a church to be more effective at reaching the lost in our community?
4. What areas might be difficult to give up in order that we might be a more effective missional church?
5. Peter had believed that it was unlawful to associate with "unclean" people, but it turns out that this was not God's law but a man-made rule that made its way into the church. Are there any traditions or rules that are rooted more in man's rules rather than the Word of God within the modern day church?
