Read together John 4:7-26

It can be easy to miss opportunities to share the gospel with those we meet. Jesus gives us a great example of how to share life-giving truth with His encounter with the woman at the well.

What is the Process?

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. Are you alert to the spontaneous moments of opportunities that God provides to share Jesus? What might be the biggest distractions that keep us from seeing and responding in obedience to these ministry moments?
3. When Jesus would dialogue with people he met, he was a master at exposing misplaced strategies to find love, acceptance, and security. Often he would use questions to draw out their motives. Are there any starter questions that you can ask, that can provide a place to begin a dialogue with others about their need for Jesus?
4. When is it appropriate to enter into debate with unbelievers? Why can debating others be counterproductive to making disciples?
5. If everyone we spend time with are believers, it can be difficult to be relevant to those outside our Christian circles. What can you do to be intentional about developing relationships with those outside your circle?

Sharing/Caring Questions

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
