Discussion Guide | November 5, 2017

Read together 1 Corinthians 15:3-6

Jesus calls His church to go and make disciples. Certainly, our lives need to display the holiness and love of Christ in order to give credibility to the gospel message. However, we also have to speak to people about Jesus clearly, that they might have opportunity to respond with faith.

What is the Process?

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. Do you know enough scripture to lead someone to Christ? If so, what verses do you use?
3. Loving people without an agenda (relationship), is an important element of effective evangelism. Why?
4. What are some common causes of fear that might keep us from sharing Jesus with those we meet or know? Which of these triggers fear in you the most?
5. What are the necessary elements that need to be communicated about Jesus for someone to have everything they need to respond to Jesus?
6. Do you have any resources/methods that help you clearly articulate the gospel? If so, can you share with the group?

Sharing/Caring Questions

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
