Read together Colossians 4:1-17

A Seat at the Table

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. When reading Col. 4, you get a sense that both evangelism and discipleship involve the community of Christians working together to accomplish these goals. Where are our strengths as a church in working together for these same goals? Where can we improve?
3. We all have a responsibility to share the mystery of Christ with those we have influence with (families, workplace, friends, etc.). What are some ways that you have been intentional to point people toward Christ in these relationships?
4. We learn from Epaphras that praying can be a hard discipline. The word "wrestle" can also be translated "struggle" and vs. 13 says he is working hard in this area. Why do you think that the prayer was a struggle and took hard work? What areas of prayer have brought you struggle?

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
