Read together 1 Peter 1:13, 4:7-11

2. What does it mean to "set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ" referred to in 1 Peter 1:13?
3. What are some things you can share with the group to help those of us who struggle with keeping clear, uninterrupted thoughts when we pray?
4. If you knew that Jesus was coming back this week, what would change in your life?
5. 1 Peter 4:10 makes clear that we are to use our gifts to serve one another. How has God gifted you to serve his church family?

Sharing/Caring Questions

2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
