Read together 2 Corinthians 4:1-6

As Christians, we are called to make disciples. Sometimes our fears and our own sense of inadequacy hold us back from taking bold risks to share our faith with others. The Apostle Paul was a master disciple-maker who overcame his fears and was faithful to the mission. Learning from his example, we too, can overcome our fears and be faithful disciple-makers.

2. What are the biggest fears that keep us from sharing the gospel with others? How can we overcome each of these fears?
3. What are some of the most common ways the Bible's message has been changed in order to appeal to more people in our culture? How has this impacted the health of the church in America?
4. How important has prayer been in your attempts to share with others in the past?
5. Can you share with the group of one person who you think you need to be intentional sharing your faith with? Will you commit to praying for and being obedient to sharing with him or her?

Sharing/Caring Questions

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
