### **Read together Matthew 26:36-39**

In Gethsemane, we can learn from Jesus' example of prayer. We are called to take our desires to Him but also to yield our will to His perfect plan. In this talk, we will unpack more of what it means to lead a bold prayer life.

3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
