



Discussion Guide | April 15, 2018

Read together | Corinthians 13:1-5

The Corinthian Church had lost its way. They were gifted by God to carry out ministry to the world and to one another, but instead, they missed the way of love. Jealousy, division, pride, and selfishness had characterized the way they related to one another. In I Corinthian 13, the Apostle Paul describes what true Christian love looks like, and challenges us to live out our faith with this kind of love.

BOLD Love - Part 2

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. How does jealousy affect our ability to love others?
3. Pride is one of those areas that can often be seen in others but hard to see within ourselves. How do you battle the sin of pride in your life?
4. Love does not insist on its own way. What is one action step you can take in your life to demonstrate this aspect of love within your family?
5. The ability to celebrate, not just tolerate, the differences and preferences of other people, shows whether you are growing in Christian maturity and love. Would you describe yourself as someone who celebrates or tolerates the differences and preferences of others?

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
