Read together 1 John 4:10, 1 Corinthians 13:6-8

In 1 Corinthians 13, Paul shares with the church that the outcome of a mature faith is not spiritual gifts, but a powerful love that comes from God. This kind of love has certain characteristics that set it apart from the way that the world loves. We should seek to love in these kinds of ways.

BOLD Love - Part 4

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. What are some specific examples of how Jesus' love endured all things with His disciples? What is the hardest barrier for you to grow in this kind of love?
3. Love does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. In what ways does our culture rejoice in wrongdoing? How should the church respond to these kinds of issues?
4. As a church, we have undergone a lot of change in this past season. With so much uncertainty, it can be easy to lose a sense of hope. What is one way that you can show a hope-filled love to others within our church?

Sharing/Caring Questions

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
