### **Read together Joshua 4**

After the Israelites crossed the Jordan, they were commanded to set up a monument of stones to remember what the Lord God did for them. In our lives, we also have moments when God has demonstrated His power and faithfulness to us. Recalling these events can encourage our faith to trust God for today.

### **Monumental Faith**

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. Can you share with the group one significant event in your life when God showed his power to you?
3. According to Joshua 4, what was the purpose that God commanded them to make a monument from stones taken from the river bottom?
4. What are some ways that you can set up a figurative monument in your life to remember God's faithfulness? How can you share it with others?
5. Is it possible to remain too fixated on past spiritual victories that you can miss God's call for your future? Explain.

### **Sharing/Caring Questions**

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
