Read together Ephesians 4:3, John 17:20-23

In John 17, Jesus prays that the church might be one in the same way that Jesus and the Father are one. Many things can destroy the bond of peace among Christians. In the verses read earlier, Jesus makes clear that there is a lot at stake through the unity that we have as believers and how that impacts our witness to the world.
