### **Read together 1 Corinthians 12:12-26**

There can be a temptation in the Christian life to think that we can manage life on our own. Nevertheless, God has intended the Church to be interdependent, since we are each gifted and called by Him to serve one other.

How do you think we at Faithbridge Church are doing in this area? How can we get better?
5. What is one step of obedience that you believe God is calling you to do in response to the truths expressed in this talk?
