### **Read together Luke 8:11-16**

Most of us start out the Christian life with an excitement and burning desire for God . But what happens when we move from spiritual vitality to spiritual stagnation? In Luke 8, Jesus warns us of this perilous condition and gives us insight into how we can be a light that burns bright.

3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
