Read together Luke 11:5-13

God calls us to bold prayer. There are many things that hinder our desire and ability to pray effectively and faithfully. Jesus invites us to overcome these barriers by sharing with us the truth about the character of our heavenly Father and His eagerness to act on behalf of His children.

BOLD Prayer - Part 3

1. What was the most significant take-away from this sermon?
2. Jesus said, "For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened." What are the biggest obstacles in your life that keep you from diligently asking and seeking God's will through your prayers?
3. Why do you think that many people view God as being a begrudging, ill-tempered God rather than a loving Father? How does our view of God's temperament affect our prayer lives?
4. God could give us everything we need without us having to pray. Why do you think that God has chosen to give to us specific needs only as we ask Him through prayer?

Sharing/Caring Questions

1. What has God been showing you this past week through His word, through life situations at home, work, church, or through other means?
2. Are there any things in your life or family we can celebrate together - spiritual or otherwise?
3. Are there any struggles or hardships in your life or family that we can pray for - spiritual or otherwise?
4. Are there any other prayer requests or specific areas the group can pray for?
