PNEUMONIA

A potentially serious and common illness in older adults and very young children is pneumonia. Pneumonia isn't always serious; it may be mild to the point that you may mistake it for a cold— sometimes referred to as 'walking pneumonia'. However, it can also develop into a dangerous infection that may require hospitalization for treatment. It can lead to signs and symptoms such as fever, chills, difficulty or pain with breathing, fatigue, or coughing.

5 COMMON TYPES

- Typical bacterial — the biggest culprit is *Streptococcus* which often occurs after you've had a cold or influenza
- Atypical bacterial — this type may be caused by *Mycoplasma*, *Legionella*, or secondary to viruses such as flu
- Fungal — this one is more likely if you have a weakened immune system or live in the Mississippi and Ohio River valleys where it may be present in animal droppings or soil
- Viral pneumonia— caused by cold and flu viruses. These are usually mild, but can become very serious.
- Aspiration pneumonia— this occurs when stomach contents, saliva or food get into the lungs. Problems swallowing, poor cough reflex, seizures and a stroke raise the risk

5 HELPFUL TREATMENTS

- Rest, stay hydrated and don't forget to take medications as instructed
- Hospitalization may be required if breathing becomes compromised, you are confused or kidney function declines
- Antibiotics are used to treat bacterial pneumonia. Antivirals and antifungal medications are used for those types
- Cough medicine that is recommended by your healthcare provider may help you to sleep. Coughing can actually be a good thing, as it helps to remove mucus from your airway
- Fever reducers such as Advil and Tylenol (ibuprofen and acetaminophen) may be taken as needed for fever and comfort

Most importantly take steps to prevent pneumonia by taking care of your health. Maintain a healthy immune system by getting enough sleep, staying active, exercising consistently, and eating nutritiously. Stay hydrated and up-to-date on your vaccines.

Remember to maintain proper hygiene practices such as frequent handwashing and avoid having close contact with those who have an obvious respiratory illness.

Remember - our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit and we are under obligation to do the best we can to take care of them.
